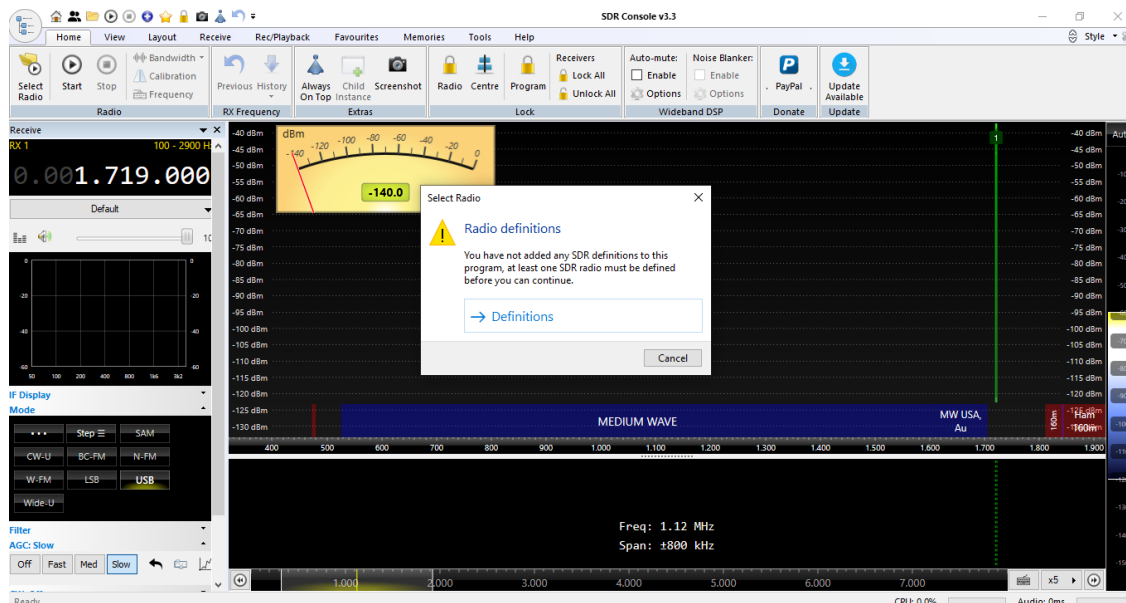
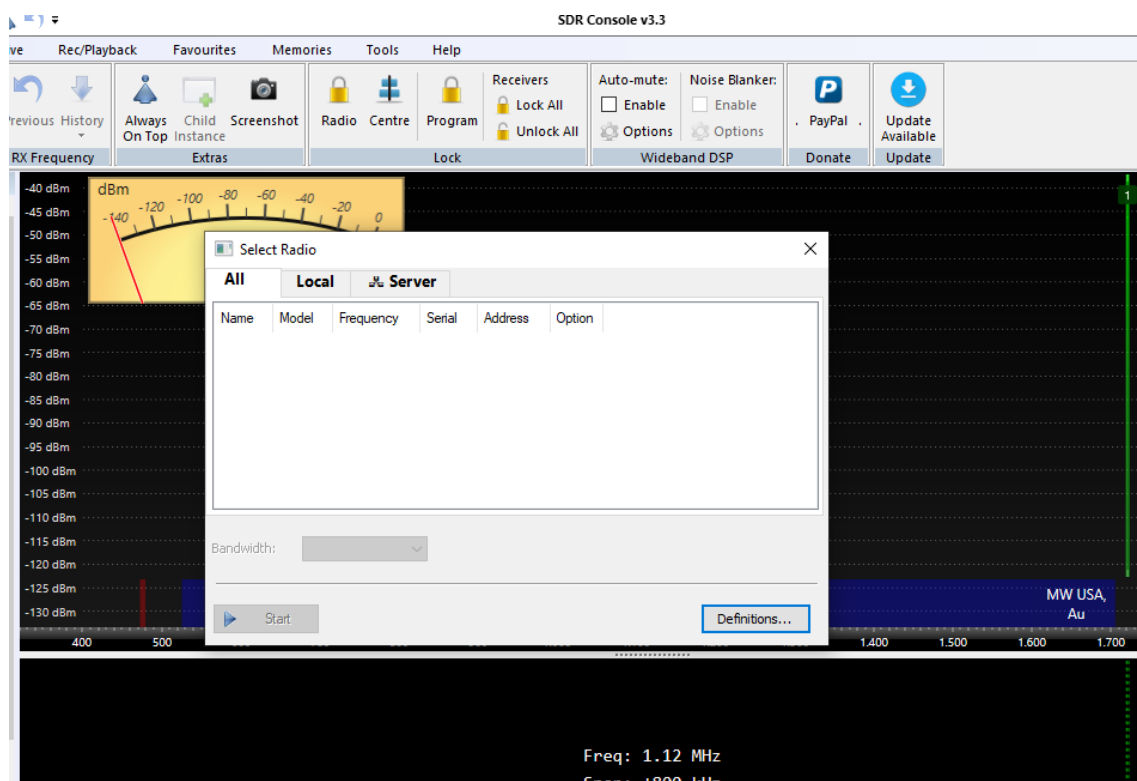


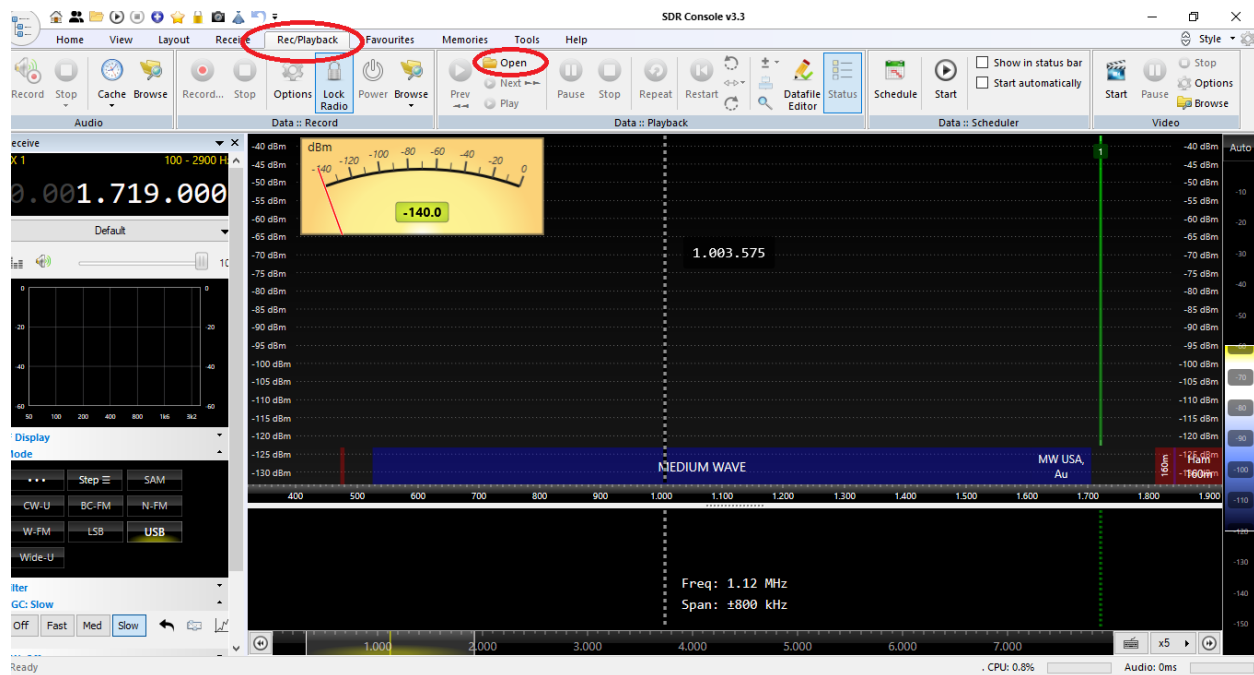
Upon opening your new installation of SDR Console, a couple of pop-up windows will appear:



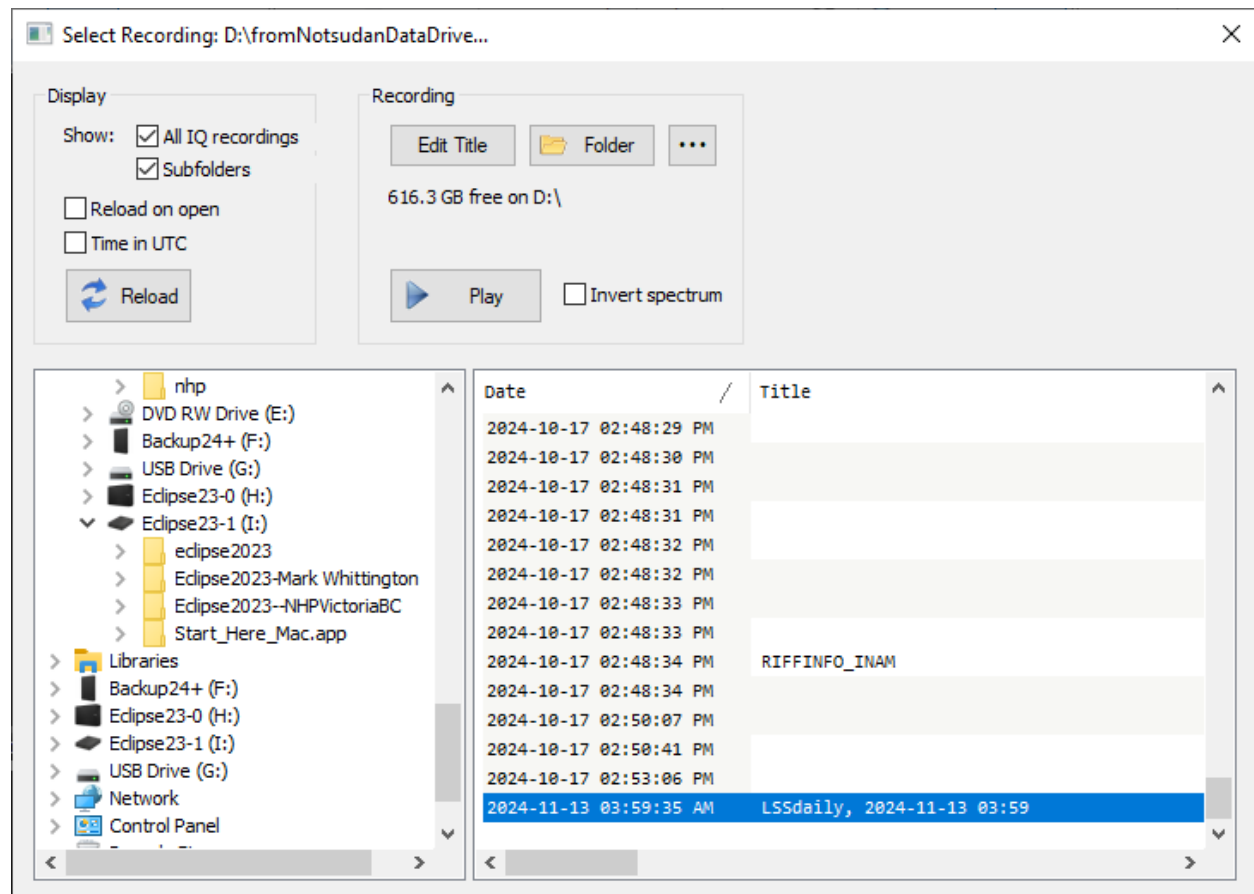
If you don't want to set up a receiver at this time, then, for the first pop-up, click "Cancel", and the second pop-up will appear:



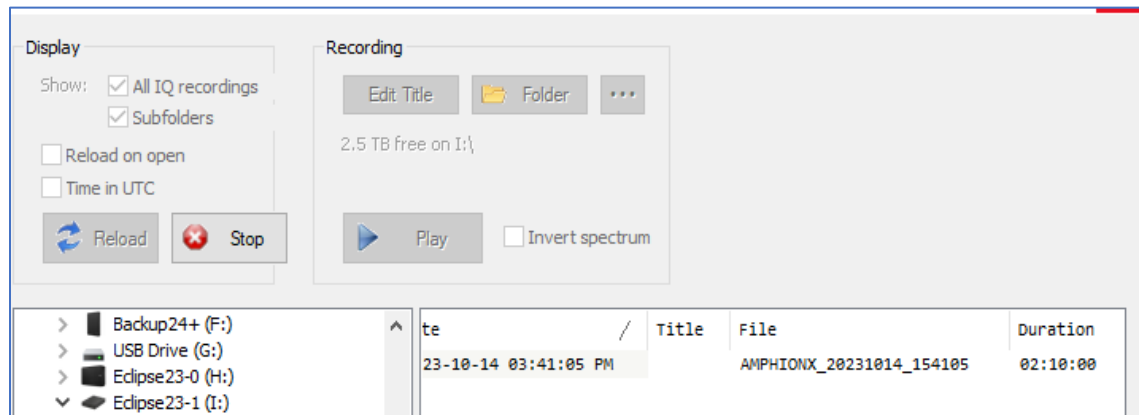
On that pop-up, click on the upper-right corner 'X' to get the unblocked Console window. Now, go to Rec/Playback on the menu bar, followed by the "Open" icon as circled in red below.



An open files window will appear:



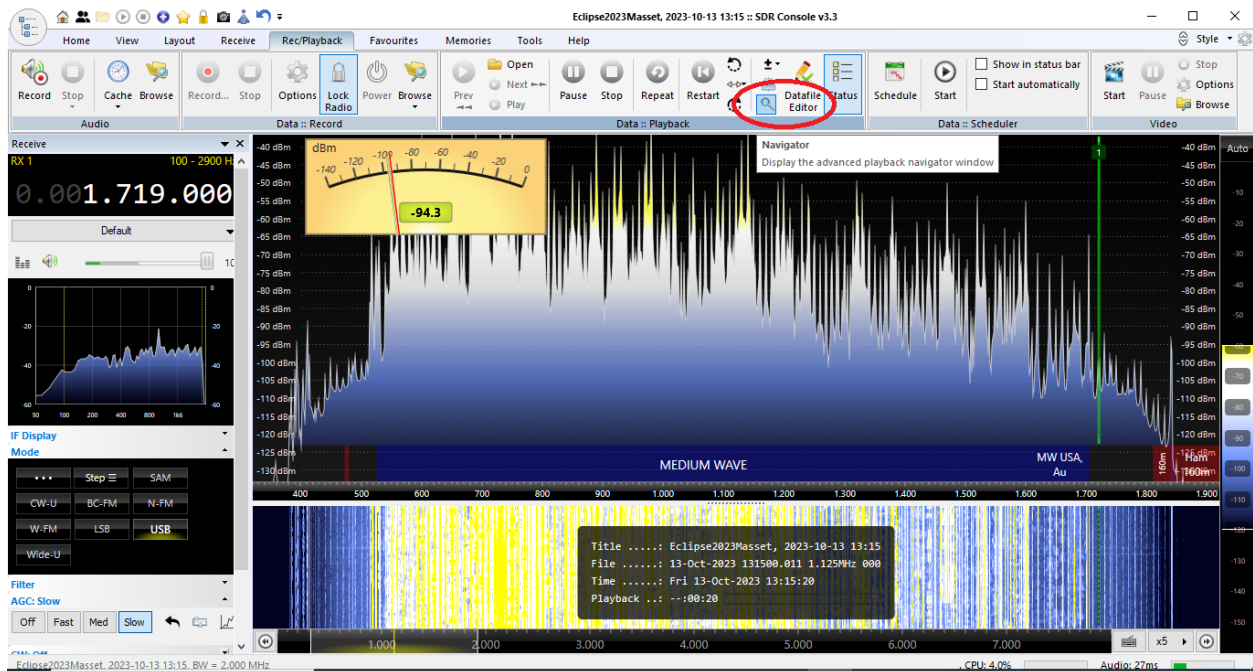
On the left panel of that window, select the directory containing the files that are to be played back. If searching for files in that directory seems to be taking too long, hit the Stop button, and try again.



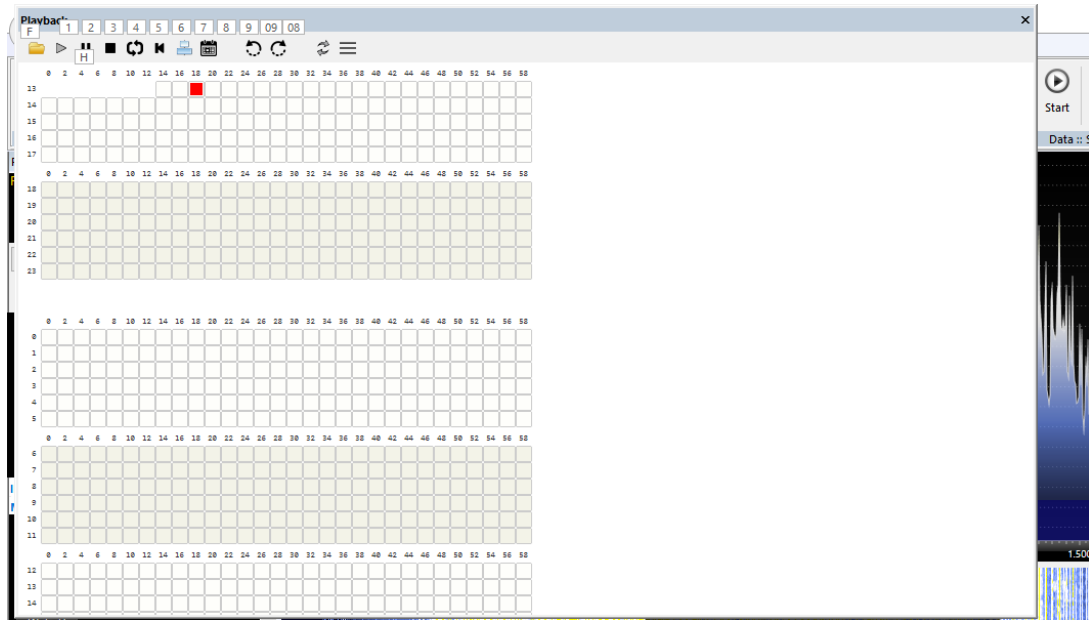
The file or files to be played from that directory will now be displayed in the right panel. Clicking on a file name will activate the Play button, which can be clicked upon to start the file playing.

Note that if the desired file is one of a series of chained files, only the first file in that chain will be displayed, and when the Play button is clicked, the first file in the chain will play.

But, what if the time period to be played is hours or even days after the chain started? Click on the magnifying glass marked "Datafile Editor" highlighted below:



The Datafile Editor allows one to visualize the whole chain of files, with hours on the Y-axis, and minutes on the X-axis, as shown below:



Clicking on the square representing the desired time will open the file corresponding to that time.
